### **Stand**

A small mobile boutique, the booth allows you to create a unique atmosphere. Available in various sizes. There are three pricing categories:

The stand is unfurnished. A **1500W electrical outlet is included**. The standard height for rigid walls is 8 feet.

Partitions, furniture, displays, layout, lighting, additional electricity, setup and dismantling are at the exhibitor's expense. Curtains used as wall replacements and draped tables are not permitted.

### 1/2 SMAQ

This year, SMAQ offers you the option to choose between participating during the first 5 days (from Thursday, December 11 to Monday, December 15 inclusive) or the last 6 days (from Tuesday, December 16 to Sunday, December 21 inclusive).

## **Weekend Tables**

Available only on weekends, these tables are reserved for exhibitors in the fine crafts section and are assigned based on availability. They offer a great opportunity to evaluate the market over a few days. The draped table measures 2'x6' (12 sq.ft) and includes one chair and a 500W electrical outlet.

Weekend spaces are available for one or two weekends and may only be shared by artisans who have a joint production (shared signature).

### Lofts

Open-concept space with carpet. It does not include partitions but comes with a 500-watt electrical outlet. This space is available in two formats:

The maximum frontage is 4 linear feet, and the depth must be between 2 and 4 linear feet. The billed area corresponds to the total space used (habitable area). The space occupied by a chair or stool required for presence in the loft is not included in the billed area.

#### **Flavors**

This section is for artisans who sell agri-food products made from original recipes. Stand spaces are assigned by the SMAQ team based on availability.

### **Exhibitors from Outside Quebec**

A \$250 discount is granted to any first-time exhibitor from outside the province of Quebec. Artisans who require a visa must submit their participation request and product selection file by July 1, 2025.

## Referral Discount (only stand)

A \$100 discount (or a credit applicable to the next event) will be granted to both the referring exhibitor and the new exhibitor.

#### Conditions:

- The new participant must not have taken part in the 2024 edition.
- When registering, the new participant must indicate the name of the referring person on their registration form so that both receive the discount/credit.

## **Liability Insurance**

The exhibitor will hold five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in liability insurance, only for this event and limited to this event only. The cost of the liability insurance is **one hundred twenty-five dollars** (\$125), plus applicable taxes and that amount is included on your bill. However, upon presentation of a liability insurance certificate from your insurer to our attention by November 15, for the event, a credit or refund will be issued.

## **Cancellation Policy**

Written request required.

- Before Sept. 15, 2025: 50% penalty
- After Sept. 15, 2025: 100% penalty

## \*General criteria

**Originality and creativity**: products must stand out for their uniqueness and have their own signature.

**Cultural respect**: no cultural appropriation.

**Level of processing**: products must involve a significant level of processing of the raw materials.

**Complete application required**: recent photos of products, website or product catalog (plus specific details for each type of entry) + production evaluation forms.

**Manufacturing**: local artisanal production (Quebec or Canada); the use of technology is accepted if integrated into an artisanal process.

**Subcontracting**: permitted only if local (Quebec/Canada).
